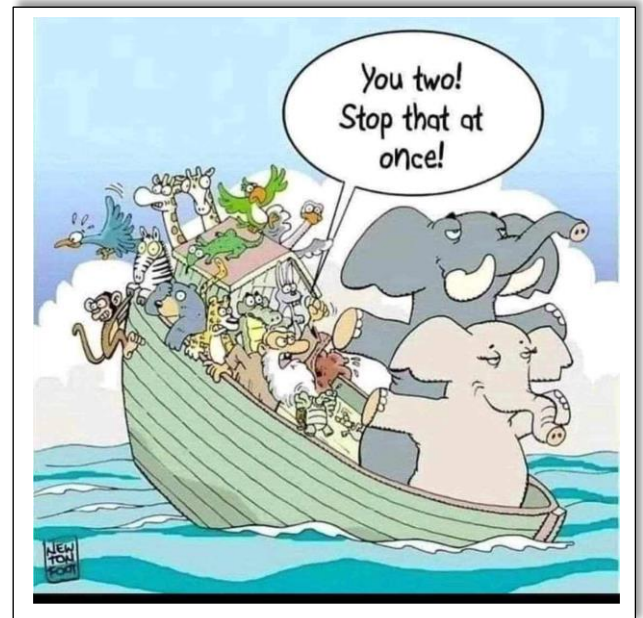


### Phone Etiquette
